The Victoria Clean Cities program will regretfully end its contract with the State Energy Conservation Office on August 31, 2009 due to lack of funding from the Department of Energy. Since Victoria Clean Cities' inception in 2006, stakeholders like you have advanced the economic, environmental and energy security goals of the United States by supporting local decisions to adopt practices that contribute to the reduction of petroleum consumption in the transportation sector.
